SEC FORM D NOTICE

Supplemental Response to Part C - Question 5

The issuer will pay PilotRock Capital, LLC (the "Administrator"), an affiliate of the General Partner of the issuer, a flat quarterly administrative fee equal to 1/4 of 1% (or 1% on an annualized basis) of the value of the net assets of the issuer as of the end of each quarter. In consideration for this quarterly fee, the Administrator will bear the administrative expenses of the issuer, except to the extent that expenses for research related services and products and certain other expenses are paid for by the issuer through "soft dollars" paid to the issuer's brokers. The quarterly fee to the Administrator may exceed the expenses borne by the Administrator on behalf of the Partnership.

The Partnership will bear expenses other than administrative expenses, such as investment expenses (e.g. brokerage commissions, clearing and settlement charges, expenses for research-related services and products, interest expense, consulting and other professional fees relating to particular investments and travel expenses incurred in connection with due diligence), legal expenses, systems and technology, audit and tax preparation expenses, organizational expenses, expenses relating to the offer and sale of the limited partnership interests and extraordinary expenses. Such expenses will be shared by all of the partners, including the General Partner. The issuer's organizational expenses are expected to be less than \$150,000 and will be amortized over a period of 60 months beginning in January 2002.

The net profits and losses of the issuer will be allocated among the partners periodically and then 20% of such allocations will be reallocated to the General Partner as of the end of each year, subject to a so-called "new high ground" (or "new high watermark") provision to the effect that if a limited partner was charged with a loss for a prior year which has not been restored by subsequent profits, then his or her proportionate share of the 20% carried interest allocable to the General Partner as described above will be reduced (but not below zero) by the amount of such loss.
