THE COURT HEREBY finds good cause and **ORDERS**:

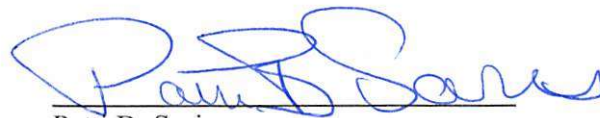
1. The Plan is approved;
