**STATUS UPDATE**

Honorable Administrative Law Judge:

ARtelligence Holdings, Inc. (“ARtelligence” or the “Company”), respectfully submits this Status Report regarding its efforts to regain compliance with SEC reporting obligations.

**I. Background and Procedural Posture**

1. All delinquent reports have been prepared internally and delivered to our PCAOB-registered independent auditor, FM Financial Services (“FMFS”) for reviews and audits.
2. On January 24, 2026, ARtelligence held a status conference with its CEO, CFO, and FMFS. Since that date, the Company has not received any audit work product, review procedures, or substantive communication regarding the required reviews and or audits.

**II. Current Financial and Operational Condition**

3. The Company’s liabilities are less than \$6.4 million – primarily loans from shareholders more than five years ago, which are in default; however, no payment has been demanded, and no litigation of any kind has been initiated or threatened. ARtelligence has no bank debt.
4. The Company’s intellectual property, the AI Visual Thesauri (the “AIVT”), was valued at \$5,230,085,000 by C. Zachary Meyers LLC, recognized by Forbes as one of “America’s Top CPAs for Valuation.”
5. The Company has no cash or income.
6. The Company’s SEC-reporting delinquency has prohibited any merger, acquisition, business combination, licensing, contracting, or financing of any nature.
7. Since May 2023, all corporate expenses have been paid by El Dorado Family Group, Ltd., which is headed by Timothy A. Holly, who also serves as Chairman and CEO for ARtelligence.

### **III. Auditor and Specialist Requirements**

10. Though FMFS has not informed ARtelligence, the PCAOB rules will require an Auditor-Engaged Specialist to independently determine the fair value of the AIVT.

11. The Company must bear the cost of the Auditor-Engaged Specialist, assuming El Dorado Family Group will be ready, willing or able to advance the engagement fees and costs.

12. Due to the lack of progress and the specialized valuation requirements, ARtelligence may need to terminate the engagement with FMFS and seek approval from the SEC Administrative Court to engage Grant Thornton LLP or another a PCAOB-registered firm having the requisite valuation and complex-asset audit capabilities.

### **IV. Request for Relief**

13. Given the multi-year gap in reporting, the complexity of the valuation work, and the need to re-establish a reliable audit foundation, ARtelligence respectfully requests authorization to prepare and file a Super 10-K covering fiscal years 2023, 2024, and 2025.


14. This consolidated filing will allow the Company to:

- Present a complete and coherent financial picture,
- Incorporate the Auditor-Engaged Specialist's valuation,
- Ensure consistency across periods, and
- Expedite the Company's return to full reporting compliance.

### **V. Conclusion**

ARtelligence remains committed to full compliance with the federal securities laws and is prepared to proceed immediately upon receiving authorization to file a Super 10-K and to engage an appropriate PCAOB-registered auditor.

**MOTION FOR LEAVE TO FILE A SUPER 10-K**

ARtelligence Holdings, Inc. (“ARtelligence” or the “Company”) respectfully moves for leave to file a consolidated Super 10-K covering fiscal years 2023, 2024, and 2025, and states as follows:

**I. Basis for the Motion**

A. The Company has not filed periodic reports since its Form 10-K for the year ended December 31, 2022. All delinquent reports have been prepared internally and delivered to our PCAOB-registered independent auditor, FM Financial Services (“FMFS”) for reviews and audits.

B. FMFS will certainly require an Auditor-Engaged Specialist to determine the fair value of the Company’s asset, the AI Visual Thesauri (“AIVT”), which a leading independent expert has valued at over \$5.23 billion.

C. The Company may need to terminate FMFS and seek approval to engage Grant Thornton LLP, or another capable PCAOB-registered firm.

D. The Company has not incurred any new liabilities, has no bank debt, and though in default on promissory notes to certain shareholders, no demand for payment has been made, and no legal action has been initiated or threatened.

E. Preparing three separate Form 10-Ks would be duplicative, inefficient, and inconsistent with the Company’s current financial structure and valuation requirements.

**II. Good Cause Exists for Granting Leave**

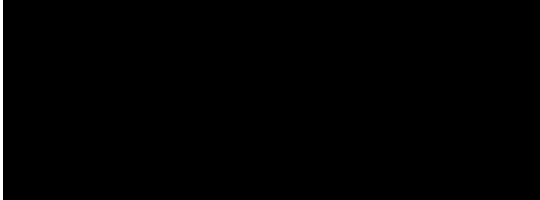
F. A consolidated Super 10-K will:

- Provide the Commission with a complete and accurate financial presentation,
- Ensure consistent application of valuation methodologies,
- Reduce unnecessary cost and delay, and
- Accelerate the Company’s return to full reporting compliance.

### **III. Relief Requested**

ARtelligence respectfully requests that the Administrative Law Judge enter an order granting leave to file a Super 10-K covering fiscal years 2023, 2024, and 2025, and granting such other relief as may be appropriate.

## DECLARATION OF TIMOTHY A. HOLLY

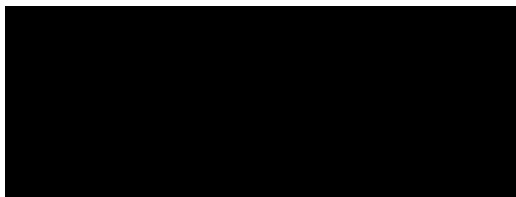
### In Support of Motion for Leave to File a Super 10-K

I, Timothy A. Holly, declare as follows:

1. I am the Chairman and Chief Executive Officer of ARtelligence Holdings, Inc.
2. I have personal knowledge of the facts set forth herein and could testify competently thereto.
3. ARtelligence has not filed periodic reports since its Form 10-K for the year ended December 31, 2022.
4. On January 24, 2026, ARtelligence held a status conference with its CEO, CFO, and FM Financial Services.
5. Since that date, the Company has not received any audit work product, review procedures, or substantive communication from FM Financial Services.
6. The Company's liabilities consist primarily of promissory notes issued more than five years ago; no holder has demanded payment, and no litigation has occurred.
7. The Company's asset, the AI Visual Thesauri (the "AIVT"), exceeds \$5.23 billion, as valued by C. Zachary Meyers LLC.
8. Since May 2023, all corporate expenses have been paid by El Dorado Family Group, Ltd., the Company's Control Person, which is headed by Timothy A. Holly.
9. The Company's auditor will be required to engage an Auditor-Engaged Specialist to determine the fair value of the AIVT asset.
10. To ensure accurate and consistent reporting, ARtelligence seeks leave to file a consolidated Super 10-K covering fiscal years 2023, 2024, and 2025.

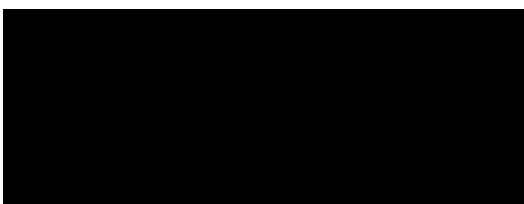
