**THE DIVISION OF ENFORCEMENT’S
FIFTH STATUS REPORT CONCERNING SERVICE**

Pursuant to the March 19, 2025 Order issued by the Securities and Exchange Commission (the “Commission”), the Division of Enforcement (the “Division”) respectfully submits this fifth status report concerning service of the Order Instituting Proceedings (“OIP”):

1. The Division of Enforcement requested that the Central Authority of Israel (the “Central Authority”) assist the Division with service in this matter pursuant to the Convention on the Service Abroad of Judicial and Extrajudicial Documents in Civil or Commercial Matters (the “Hague Convention”) to which Israel is a signatory.

2. Article 5(a) of the Hague Convention requires the Central Authority to arrange for service by a method prescribed by Israel’s internal law for the service of documents in domestic actions upon persons within Israel.

3. The Central Authority has certified that, on August 25, 2025, Respondent Ronn Ben Harav (a/k/a Ronen Baharav) was served with the following papers in accordance with Article 5(a) of the Hague Convention:
