**AMENDED FINAL JUDGMENT BY DEFAULT AS TO RELIEF DEFENDANT
LANDES AND COMPAGNIE TRUST PRIVE A/K/A LANDES AND
COMPAGNIE TRST PRIVE KB**

On October 31, 2024, the court entered judgment against relief defendants Landes Prive, LLC, Landes and Compagnie Trust Prive a/k/a Landes and Compagnie Trst Prive KB (Landes KB) and HekYeah, LLC. Dkt. No. 72. The plaintiff settled with relief defendant Justin Smith, making Smith's liability joint and several with Landes KB. The court **ORDERS** that the entry of final judgment against Landes KB is amended as follows:

Landes KB is liable for disgorgment representing net profits gained as a result of the conduct alleged in the complaint, together with prejudgment

interest thereon, joint and severally with relief defendant Justin D. Smith, as follows:

Relief Defendant	Disgorgement Amount	Prejudgment Interest	Total
Landes KB	\$297,700	\$38,371	\$336,071

Landes KB shall satisfy its obligation by paying \$336,071 to the Securities and Exchange Commission within 30 days after entry of this final judgment.

Landes KB may transmit payment electronically to the Commission, which will provide detailed ACH transfer/Fedwire instructions upon request. Payment may also be made directly from a bank account via Pay.gov through the SEC website at <http://www.sec.gov/about/offices/ofm.htm>. Landes KB may also pay by certified check, bank cashier's check, or United States postal money order payable to the Securities and Exchange Commission, which shall be delivered or mailed to

and shall be accompanied by a letter identifying the case title, civil action number, and name of this court; Landes KB as a relief defendant in this action; and specifying that payment is made in compliance with this final judgment.

Landes KB shall simultaneously transmit photocopies of evidence of payment and case identifying information to the Commission's counsel in this action. By making this payment, Landes KB relinquishes all legal and equitable


right, title, and interest in such funds and no part of the funds shall be returned to Landes KB.

The Commission may enforce the court's judgment for disgorgement and prejudgment interest by using all collection procedures authorized by law, including, but not limited to, moving for civil contempt at any time after 30 days following entry of this Final Default Judgment. Landes KB shall pay post judgment interest on any amounts due after 30 days of the entry of this final judgment under 28 U.S.C. §1961.

The court **ORDERS** that this court shall retain jurisdiction of this matter for the purposes of enforcing the terms of this final judgment.
